Part 2: Conditions of exhibition

Prohibited equipment

The display of the following equipment and products is prohibited at IDEX. It is implicit in this statement that the promotion of such products and services relating to them, in any form, including in brochures, in electronic format or in any promotional material, is also prohibited.

- a. Weapons of mass destruction.
- b. Restraints specially designed for restraining human beings as follows:
 - i. Leg irons, gang chains, shackles¹ and individual cuffs or shackle bracelets, except those that are ordinary hand cuffs²
 - ii. Restraint chairs, unless designed for disabled persons
 - iii. Thumb cuffs and thumbscrews, including serrated thumb cuffs.
 - iv. Electric shock belts³
- c. Portable devices designed or modified for the purpose of riot control or self-protection by the administration of an electric shock, including electric-shock batons, sting sticks, electric-shock shields, stun guns, electric shock dart guns⁴ and components specifically designed or modified for such purposes.
- d. Anti-personnel mines, anti-material cartridges and all other forms of land-mines.
- e. All forms of cargo munitions, cluster bombs and other battlefield non-unitary munitions, including those with a self-destruct/self-deactivation capability.
- f. Equipment designed to be used for torture or ill-treatment.

Footnotes:

1 Shackles designed for restraining human beings having an overall dimension, including chain, when measured from the outer edge of one cuff to the outer edge of the other cuff, of between 240mm and 280mm, when locked.

2 Ordinary handcuffs are handcuffs which have a dimension, including chain, measured from the outer edge of one cuff to the outer edge of the other cuff, of between 150mm and 240mm, when locked, and have not been modified to cause physical pain or suffering.

3 Electric-shock belts designed for restraining human beings by the administration of electric shocks having a no-load voltage not exceeding 10,000 volts.

4 Electric shock dart guns having a no-load voltage not exceeding 10,000 volts, including Tasers

Any queries should be referred to the Organiser, whose decision is final. Nothing in this form shall absolve any exhibitor from ensuring that he has in place the appropriate licences and mechanisms as dictated by relevant national legislation.

Exhibitors will not be permitted to exhibit if their sole or predominant aim is the import of military goods by a third party for immediate resale.

Part 3: Declaration

All exhibitors are required to read and complete the following declaration:

DECLARATION

We understand that it is a condition of the licensing authority that no weapon, ammunition or toxic material will be exhibited at IDEX other than dummies, inert ammunition or weapons that are incapable of firing or discharge. In the case of the latter, weapons that are imported into the UAE for display at IDEX must be “incapacitated” from the time of entry into the country until their subsequent export from the UAE. The list of items for display that fall in to the categories of weapons or ammunition, whether actual, dummy, cutaway or inert, is indicated on part 4 of this form.

Within the consignment of exhibits and materials shipped to Abu Dhabi for display at IDEX are the following items, listed on part 4 of this form, which fall under the definition of weapons, ammunition, projectile or mine.

1. Dummy or an Inert is defined “as any item or armament or any projectile, which contains no explosive, incendiary or toxic material and has been rendered inert to a degree from which it cannot be repaired to become a usable weapon or projectile in a weapon”.
2. Part 4 of this form must include all products you intend to exhibit / demonstrate at IDEX 2015.
3. The security staff will screen all exhibits before they are delivered to their respective stands and / or demonstration areas.
4. In the event of any contravention of the compliance regulations, the organisers will take appropriate action which may include closure of the offending exhibitor’s stand, without refund or recompense
