

## CYBER INTELLIGENCE ASIA

12-15 March 2013, Royale Chulan Hotel, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

The launch of *Cyber Intelligence Asia* took place at the Royale Chulan Hotel in Kuala Lumpur with approximately 90-100 attendees present.

The event attracted delegations from 16 countries to discuss the latest cyber security policies and strategies in their respective countries. Cyber Intelligence Asia had delegates from the following government organisations/agencies: National Security Council (Malaysia), CyberSecurity Malaysia, Prime Minister's Department (Malaysia), Sabah State Computer Services Department (Malaysia), MIMOS (Malaysia), CamCERT, JPCERT, ID-CERT, IMPAC T, ITU, US Government, Information Technology Authority (Oman), DIWAN (Oman), Ministry of Defence (Singapore), DSO Laboratories (Singapore), FBI (USA), US Department of State, US Embassy, German Embassy, Hong Kong Police Force, United Nations, Ministry of ICT (Thailand) and Russian Law Enforcement Agency.

With the support and assistance of CyberSecurity Malaysia the event was opened by *Ir. Md Shah Nuri Bin Md Zain, Under Secretary Cyber & Space Security Division, National Security Council, Prime Minister's Department, Malaysia* who provided an overview of cyber security in Malaysia and how the National Security Council interlink with the local law enforcement agencies and other government departments such MICC, AGC and MOSTI.

Day One continued with an overview of Cyber Security issues and challenges in Malaysia from the Peninsula and Sabah State, before moving to a global perspective by the International Telecommunications Union (ITU) and IMPACT who delivered presentations on their work across the globe encouraging international cooperation similar to the Budapest Cybercrime Convention.

The afternoon of Day One focused on neighbouring countries in ASEAN with presentations discussing DDoS attacks and cyber-crime updates from Japan and Thailand.

The conference concluded with a drinks reception in the exhibition hall kindly hosted by Deloitte providing great networking opportunities for the public and private sector attendees to discuss the latest solutions available and what is currently needed by the public sector to combat cyber-crimes.

The exhibition included companies from across ASEAN and USA: Codenomicon, DataExpert Technology, EC-Council Academy, ElcomSoft, Emerging Threats, Hacking Team, Transition Asia and Websense.

During the conference on day one we heard insightful presentations from Websense and EC-Council Academy. Brandon Tan from Websense presented on the "Seven stages of advanced threats and data theft" and Drew Williams from Condition Zebra/EC-Council Academy discussed "The virtues and vices of BOYD".

Day Two started with an opening address by the *Honourable (Prof.) Howard Schmidt* who provided the audience with an overview of cyber security in the US and the recent executive order that President Obama and his Administration have put forward. Professor Schmidt urged for more dialogue between public and private sector and that there needed to be common ground made between the US and China rather than accusing each other over cyber-attacks.

This was followed by Matt Jonkman, CTO and Emerging Threats who discussed the latest Malware solutions and IDS update.

Presentations from CamCERT, ID-CERT, JPCERT allowed the audience to hear case studies from these countries that gave a great insight to the challenges CERT's are faced with on a weekly basis.

The conference finished with a presentation by Bruce Wynn who provided the audience with an insightful look into the world of a hacker and provided a good summary of the conference that had taken place over the last couple of days.




